



EMERGENCY NEEDS ASSESSMENT: QUESTIONS ON CHILDREN

Are there children at this site who have been separated from their usual caregivers?

Approximately what proportion of households at this site have at least one child separated from them?

What do you think are the main causes of separations?

Approximately what proportion of households at this site have at least one child under 18 years engaged in employment outside of this site?

Approximately what proportion of households at this site have at least one child under 18 years who is married?

What do you think are the main safety and security concerns for girls at this site?

What do you think are the main safety and security concerns for boys at this site?

Are there any areas or places at this site that women and girls avoid because they feel unsafe?

What areas or places do women and girls avoid or feel unsafe about?

Observe: Approximately how many children are living in the street?

Observe: are there children in military uniforms or in outfits that symbolize association with armed groups?

Observe: are there children who appear to be actively involved in combat functions (e.g. operating checkpoints)?

Observe: Do children appear to be involved in child labour?

Observe: Do children appear to be involved in chores that require travelling long distances (e.g., collecting wood, fetching water)?

Observe: children are out of school, do they have a safe place to play and learn?

Do children have meaningful opportunities to participate in National Society decisions that affect them?

What age categories of children have had meaningful opportunities to participate?

What ways have children participated?
