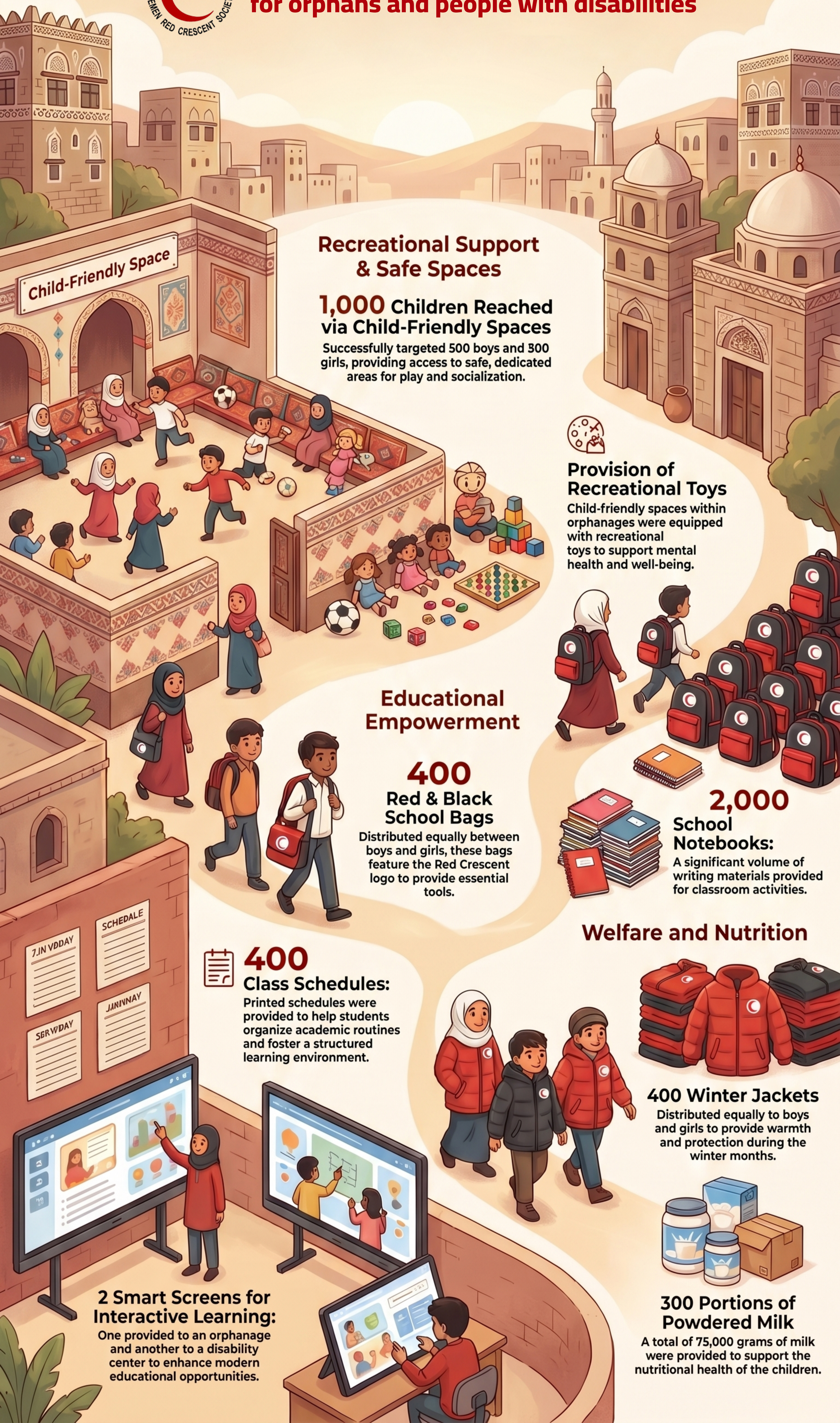


Activities implemented under the CAAC project for orphans and people with disabilities



Recreational Support & Safe Spaces

1,000 Children Reached via Child-Friendly Spaces

Successfully targeted 500 boys and 300 girls, providing access to safe, dedicated areas for play and socialization.



Provision of Recreational Toys

Child-friendly spaces within orphanages were equipped with recreational toys to support mental health and well-being.

Distributed equally between boys and girls, these bags feature the Red Crescent logo to provide essential tools.

400 Winter Jackets

Distributed equally to boys and girls to provide warmth and protection during the winter months.



300 Portions of Powdered Milk

A total of 75,000 grams of milk were provided to support the nutritional health of the children.

One provided to an orphanage and another to a disability center to enhance modern educational opportunities.
